Cross-Generational Relationship-Building Curriculum for Sunday Mornings

What is Sunday LIFT?

Sunday LIFT is a resource for churches looking to build cross-generational relationships on Sunday morning. It may take the place of other Christian education or formation ministries or may be used in addition to programming that already exists within your church.

Sunday LIFT brings generations together around tables with the sharing of food, fellowship and learning.

A typical session of Sunday LIFT looks like this:

- Welcome and opening grace
- Sharing a snack or meal at tables
- Reading a Bible story or scripture followed by conversation and reflection
- Responsive activity that allows for playing together
- Closing prayer, song, or responsive reading

Each one-hour session comes with these pieces laid out. If it makes more sense for you to end with a meal, then move pieces around.
